**The Angela Redford Trophy Trial
Round 3 of the ACU Traditional Trials Championship

Supplementary Regulations**

Announcement: Lancs County Motor Cycle Club Ltd will organise the third round of the ACU Traditional Trials Championship, a national sporting trial for solo machines, to be held under the Auto Cycle Union National Sporting Code, the Standing Regulations for Trials, the following Supplementary regulations and any final instructions which may be issued.

Eligibility: All riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration Card or a Scottish ACU licence. Any other riders, including Irish participants must obtain personal accident insurance, produce a licence issued by their FMN and start permission confirming they are licensed and insured. Priority of entry will be given to Championship point scorers from the current series and last year, subject to completed entry forms being received.

Classes:

Class A: Machines of a type manufactured in Great Britain prior to 1975.

Class B: Machines with twin-shock rear suspension not included in Class A.

Class C: Machines with monoshock rear suspension and an air-cooled engine.

Class D: Machines not included in classes A, B and C, but ridden by competitors over 40 years of age.

Class E: Machines not included in classes A, B, C and D, but ridden by competitors over 50 years of age.

Class F: Machines not included in classes A, B, C, D and E, but ridden by a competitor over 60 years old.

Priority of entry will be given to Classic Championship entrants, however, should the entry not reach the maximum, the balance may be filled with non-championship clubmen riders who would start first.

Entries: The entry fee is £20.00, **start time and results will be communicated by e-mail** unless two stamped, self-addressed envelopes are supplied, and is inclusive of Drivers Personal Accident, Third Party Insurance [off-road risks only] and ACU entry subscription. Entry fees will only be returned if the trial is cancelled or postponed for more than 24 hours and would be subject to an administration charge of £5. The closing date for entries will be Saturday, March 6th. Riding numbers will be allocated by class in reverse order of receipt starting with class D, then C, B, E, F and A. Each class will ride the sections in the same order but whole classes will be sent to start at different sections.

Cheques should be made payable to Lancs County MCC Ltd.

Start time: The first rider will start at 10.01am with machine examination taking place from 9.00am

Venue: Brookhouse Brickworks and Anna's Ghyll, Caton, Lancs, which will be flagged from the A 683 Lancaster to Kirkby Lonsdale road at Caton.

Course: The course will be two laps of 20 sections. No road work is included, but riders need to cross a minor road during the event.

Method of marking: The ACU system, TSR 22B (no stop permitted) will be used

Time: A time limit to be announced at the start will be imposed; late starting and late finishing will be penalised by one mark for each minute late up to a maximum of 20 minutes and thereafter riders will be excluded.

Awards: The overall best performance of the day will be awarded the Angela Redford Trophy. Winners of other classes will receive a suitable trophy, whilst the first 15 places in each class will be awarded British Championship points on a sliding scale.

Refreshments: A refreshment van will be at the start. Petrol is available in Caton. There are no camping facilities available.

Results: Results will be available from about 8pm the evening of the trial on the club's website,

www.lancscountymcc.co.uk, they will be e-mailed at the same time, displayed at the following day's Bootle trial and posted as normal as soon as possible.
